

Dear Parents and Carers

Welcome to the final term of this academic year. This is the long stretch before the summer break and is filled with exciting trips, events and activities. Please remember that the children will need hats, sunscreen and water bottles if the warm weather continues, as well as a raincoat for the odd downpour!

This term we will be thinking a lot about transition. We welcome all our new Reception children for September 2025 for their induction visits and our Year 6 children will be visiting their Secondary Schools. We will also be thinking about moving up to new classes for all our other year groups. During this term, the teachers will be working out the classes for September 25; all children will be mixed up again, but staff will ensure that each child has 1 or 2 particular friends in their new classes with them. This information will come home to you via letter later on this term. Our number on roll for this next academic year has dropped as we have a lower number of new Reception starters; therefore, we will have 13 classes instead of 14. There will be no change next year in Key Stage 2 but in EYFS and KS1 we will have mixed aged classes. The children will be organised as follows in lower school:

Yr R – Spring & Summer born Yr R

Yr R & 1 – Autumn born Yr R & some Yr 1

3x mixed Yr 1 & 2 classes

We will continue to offer our Orchard intervention provision, but this will move into the main building in the current Yr 2 Willow classroom. All KS1 and EYFS children will start the school day with doors opening at 08:35 and the register at 08:45.

At the end of this term, we will be saying goodbye to Miss Johnson (Birch), as she has successfully obtained a new teaching post closer to her home. As you already know, Mr McKinnon (Aspen) is leaving us as well this term. We also say goodbye to Mrs Bacon, our School Business Manager in July and Mrs Goodwin, a current Yr 6 teaching assistant. We wish them all the best for the future.

We welcome, 2 new teachers to Covingham Park to replace Mr McKinnon and Miss Johnson. They are Miss Drury and Mrs Colon. We hope to see them on class move up day. We also welcome back Mrs Tarrant (nee Miss Davies) from maternity leave – she will be in Maple class from 14th July and Miss Patten will return to Covingham Park in September.

Last term we had the Year 6 SATs, and this term we have the Year 4 Multiplication Check, and Year 1 Phonics Test. Please see the dates below and ensure that your Year 4 and Year 1 children are in school during these weeks. Any new dates or information has been highlighted in purple for ease.

Finally, your child's teacher is busy writing their end of year report. After this is sent home, you will have the opportunity to discuss it with your child's teacher should you so wish to, this is not an official 'parent's evening'.

We look forward to seeing you all the different assemblies and events this term. There are lots of opportunities for you to come in this term, including the new 'Headteacher open session' – an opportunity to come in and chat with me (no appointment necessary) – please see dates on the calendar below.

In many ways, mental health is just like physical health: everybody has it and we need to take care of it.

- Good mental health means being generally able to think, feel and react in the ways that you need and want to live your life. But if you go through a period of poor mental health you might find the ways you're frequently thinking, feeling or reacting become difficult, or even impossible, to cope with. This can feel just as bad as a physical illness, or even worse.
- Mental health problems affect around one in four people in any given year. They range from common problems, such as depression and anxiety, to rarer problems such as schizophrenia and bipolar disorder.
