Dear Parents and Carers

We hope that you all had a safe and enjoyable half term break.

Welcome back to Term 2, with darker evenings and colder days! It was lovely to see so many of you at our end of term Harvest event and the cosy book evening, we look forward to seeing you all again for the Christmas activities.

Next holiday (Christmas) many of you will receive the HAF vouchers for your child. If your child is entitled to Free School Meals (FSM) you should receive the voucher for them – if you have other children in your family (potentially younger ones at school) then please ensure that you have registered them for the Free School Meal (FSM) scheme as well. Free School Meals means that your child is entitled to a free hot meal every day (although you can still opt to bring a packed lunch if you choose), you will then receive the holiday vouchers 3 times a year for your child. The school will also receive money for your child. This means we can help you by paying an amount towards school trips, uniform or other activities such as after school club or music lessons.

Free School Meals (FSM) eligibility is determined by income/benefit, whereas the Universal Free Infant School Meals (UIFSM) offers a hot dinner to all children in EYFS & KS1 and does not come with any additional funding or vouchers. If your younger child has the Universal Infant Meal, you may still be entitled to Free School Meals (FSM) with additional funding attached – please speak to the Office who will give you a Free School Meal eligibility form to complete.

This term we continue our Open Morning visits for any Yr R pupils for September 2025 – if you have a child who will start in Yr R in September 2025, please look out for the visit dates.

We will also be holding Parent's evenings this term - you can sign up for your slot via Parent mail.

Over the half term, I was shocked to see the amount of school unform in lost property that was unnamed – this included coats and shoes, as well as sports kit and football boots. We know how expensive these items are – please ensure your child's clothing is labelled. Please take time to look through the lost property boxes in KS2 if your child is missing items. Anything that is not labelled or unclaimed will donate to the FoS Pre-loved stall or it will be donated to charity.

Finally, some more staffing news. At the end of this term, we say goodbye to Miss Brown, who is leaving teaching. She has been at Covingham for 10 years and has taught across the school. I am sure that you join with us to wish Miss Brown well for her new adventures ahead.
