As you may be aware, there is an expectation from the Government that all state-funded mainstream schools will deliver a minimum length of school week of 32.5 hours from September 2023.

From September, we will be extending the school day to include more learning time and will be moving towards a school week of 32.5 hours.

FS2	Will remain as it currently is: 8:45-3:00 (Monday-Thurs) and 8:45-2:10 (Friday).
KS1	Will be 8:35- 3:10 (Mon- Thurs) and 8:35- 2:10 (Friday)
	Children can be dropped to the classroom door between 8:35-8:45. A teacher and TA will be in class and a child-led activity will be available for children to complete as they arrive. Registration will be completed at 8:45.
KS2	Will be 8:30- 3:15 (Mon- Thurs) and 8:30- 2:00 (Friday)
	Playground gates will be open for children to arrive from 8:30 – 8:40am. Children will complete an activity as they arrive. Registration will be completed at 8:45.
	Liaison with parents will be available at the end of the school day only. For urgent messages, please contact the school office.
	All KS2 children can use either gate. At the end of the school day, Y3 teachers will be available by the gates to the basketball court, Y6 teachers by the main gates the playground and Y4 and Y5 teachers by the rear gate to the park.
	One member of staff will be available on both the front and rear gates at the start of the day, on a rota basis.

The length of the school day will be as follows:

We will gradually move registration time earlier to ensure a school week of 32.5 hours.
